Suitor John Doe's one supreme Court has entered a final Decision, Judgment, and Disposition of the above matter finding John doe, a private individual, not a United States citizen, person, not subject to the jurisdiction of the United States, nor the uniform State laws of national application; and that no crime has been committed as asserted by the State of what state in its State Court and the United States District Court for the District of what state.

The jury further found John Doe is the victim of a maritime scheme, and John Doe is being held unlawfully, as an alleged criminal to answer in those inferior cases.

This Court further found that the United States District Court does not have jurisdiction to consider all of John Doe's Rights, as the summary remand dealt only with civil rights, which constitute a substantial departure in the character of the constitutional protection, accorded fundamental Rights of John Doe.

Accordingly, the order of summary remand is not binding precedent under the laws of John Doe's Case and the summary remand is set aside as inferior by the attached judgment established by John Doe's one supreme Court's supervisory control; appellate review, as Conditions Precedent, in this appropriate (one's own) action.

Rule 81(b) provided the exception to the District Court Rules and 28 U.S.C. 2072(b) regulates, because all laws in conflict with such rule shall be of no further force or effect, and such rules of the District Court shall not abridge John Doe's fundamental (substantive) right to my Court. This Writ is issued by necessity under 28 U.S.C. 1651(a), in aid of my one supreme Court's jurisdictions.

The attached judgment made by John Doe's one supreme Court is supreme Law made by the People of the United States, in Pursuance of the United States Constitution, which binds public

functionaries, whether of the United States, or of the States, which shall be the supreme Law of the Land; and the Judges in every State shall be bound thereby, any thing in the Constitution or Laws of any State to the contrary, notwithstanding. Article 6 Section 2 United States Constitution.

Judge Name's discretion is eliminated by the above clearly established rules and Law. There are no Courts of the United States having supreme Jurisdiction to review and overrule the Judgment, and the matter is final. Any error or defect in the proceedings is harmless because no substantive rights have been affected.

Senior Judge Name has the ministerial, mandatory duty imposed upon him/her at Article 6 Section 2 of the United States Constitution, and by Suitor's Name as his/her superior authority, in this guaranteed Republican Form of Government.

John Doe is vested with a lawful fundamental right to enjoy the Decision, Judgment, and Disposition of the matter by his one supreme Court and the State of Name has a corresponding duty; because any Thing in the Constitution or laws of any State contrary to the Judgment, notwithstanding. This Writ of Mandamus is an appropriate and adequate remedy assigned to Judge's Name to faithfully execute the Decition, Judgment, and Disposition, as a supreme Law of the United States, in respect to John Doe, commanding at all times obedience to the instructions, herein.

Judge's Name, you have all necessary authority conferred upon you agreeable to the wages prescribed in this Peremptory Writ of Mandamus, but you do not have jurisdiction to act contrary to the principles of Law and Fact contained in this Mandamus and the Decision, Judgment, and Disposition attached hereto.

Therefore, Senior Judge's Name is commanded to order the Judge of the Name of inferior court to cease and desist all actions and proceedings in inferior court case # against John Doe, forthwith, without any delay, and provide John Doe with copies of such orders and other necessary process.
